June 10 | 8am-10am
Job Scheduling is the Key to Success

2 credit hours — taught by Justin Zeller

This course focuses on how to create a schedule and why a schedule is important for making money, client happiness, and increased professionalism.

June 11 | 8am-1pm
Residential Blueprint Reading

5 credit hours — taught by Carlos Lora

This course will provide students with an introduction to the area of residential blueprint reading, construction documents/ calculations, and project specifications.

Construction Accounting Software

Learn the best practices for selecting and implementing the right accounting software for your company.

Accounting and Cash Flow

The course will help a contractor understand the basics of accounting and how to manage cash flow

Deck codes and construction

Learn what you need to design and build code-compliant decks using prescriptive measures outlined in the code and code-compliant standards.
